

Ilsington Community Project Update - Shop and Meeting Room

We have now raised nearly £4000 from our community through the sale of shares, slates and donations received.

Building Plans - We have been fortunate enough to secure a grant of £3,834 from Grassroots to put towards the cost of initial plans. So, with funds in hand, we have canvassed several local firms and are on the verge of appointing an architect to draw up construction drawings outlining the building specifications. These will then be forwarded to a selection of building firms for tendering - all very exciting stuff!

<u>Sustainable Energy</u> - we are waiting for several quotes on various renewable energy options for the project.

Questionnaire - An important questionnaire will be winging its way into homes in the parish over the next few weeks and we would hugely appreciate it if you could take the time to fill it in and leave it out for collection on the date specified on the form.
