Building

The architects' drawings are very nearly complete and, when the required building regulations have been granted and the specifications drawn up will shortly be sent out to tender.

<u>Funding</u>

Fund raising is ever ongoing and we have recently heard that we have been successful in our application for a $\pm 20,000$ grant from the Plunkett Foundation. We are also awaiting approval of a $\pm 20,000$ loan from the Coop Bank.

On a more local level, the Ilsington Art Show very kindly contributed ± 175 from their annual show last weekend and we received ± 625 from the Cycling and Walking fundraiser in May. **Thank You**.

The Community Market continues to provide not only a steady income, over £1000, from the teas but also keeps the Project very much at the forefront of local events.
