The application is for the Sale by Retail of Alcohol – Mon-Sat 8am-7.30pm and Sun 9am-12noon.

A copy of the application can be viewed, by appointment, at the Licensing Authority's address during normal office hours (Monday to Thursday 8.30am to 5pm and Friday 8.30am to 4.30pm).

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is not exceeding £5,000.
